ORDER

Vide paper read as (1), permission has been granted for re-admission of regular students of 2013 and earlier admission of semester system (CCSS) to the present batch (CUCBCSS UG 2014) fulfilling certain conditions.

Vide paper read as (2), permission has been granted for re-admission of SDE/Private students of 2013 and earlier admission of semester system (CCSS) to the present batch (CUCBCSS UG 2014).

Vide paper read as (3), clarifications has been sought by SDE regarding re-admission of Regular candidates of 2013 and earlier admission of semester system (CCSS) to the present batch (CUCBCSS UG 2014) under SDE.

The Steering Committee on CBCSS UG 2014 vide paper read as (4), has resolved to permit readmission of Regular Students of CCSS Scheme to SDE/Private mode under CUCBCSS Scheme.

Considering the exigency, the Vice Chancellor, in exercising the powers of the Academic council, has approved the resolution of the Steering Committee vide paper read as (5), subject to ratification by the Academic Council.

Sanction has therefore been accorded to permit readmission of Regular Students of CCSS Scheme (2013 and earlier admissions) to SDE/Private mode of CUCBCSS UG 2014 Scheme with the following conditions:

1. Assure that 120 credits are done.
2. If course/courses are duplicated, eliminate the duplicated course/courses by taking the highest grade/marks of the said course.
3. If there is duplication of course/courses, the credit transfer mechanism suggested by the Board of Studies concerned need to be sought.
4. The Principal shall forward the internal marks of the course to be taken by the student in order to have the balance of the credit of 120.

5. Students shall appear for the special/regular exam of the deficient course at their own cost.
6. During re-admission to CUCBCSS, if a candidate has already done a course/courses in CCSS, which is similar in Syllabus and with same credit, the Internal Grade Point is to be multiplied by 5 and the External Grade Point to be multiplied by 20 in order to calculate the percentage and hence, to determine the corresponding marks.

Orders are issued accordingly.
