ELIGIBILITY RULES FOR PRIVATE REGISTRATION

Those candidates who are "Eligible for Higher Studies" as per the Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala or a pass in the equivalent examinations is the minimum criteria for admission to degree programmes, unless otherwise specified(U.O.No.393/2015/Admn dated 10.03.2015)

However, candidates who have qualified the HSE and VHSE of the Government of Kerala under 'SAY' scheme and Compartmental Examination of CBSE are also eligible for admission to first year degree programmes in the same academic year(U.O.No.GA I/A2/5753/2000 dated 14.05.2004)

Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary Examination of Tamil Nadu(Private Study) shall not be admitted to any programme under this University(U.O.No.GAI/A1/5062/2002 dated 07.07.2005)

The Afzal-ul-ulama preliminary course is declared equivalent to the Plus Two Humanities Group. Therefore, all candidates passed Afzal-ul-ulama preliminary are eligible for admission to the Humanities and Commerce programmes.(G.O.(rt) 2165/2014 H.Edn dated 03.06.2014).

14	B.Com	Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto with at least one Commerce subject are eligible for admission to the B.Com Degree Programme. Candidates who have not studied commerce subject for Higher Secondary or an equivalent examination with not less than 45% marks are also eligible. A concession of 5% marks will be given to OBC/OEC candidates. The SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.
15	B.B.A(Bachelor of Business Administration)	Candidates who have passed(Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto, with not less than 50% marks is eligible for admissions. A concession of 5% marks will be given to OBC/OEC candidates. The SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.(U.O.No. GA I/J2/2907/2003.

Relaxation of minimum marks will be given as per rules.

The printout of the application along with the required documents should be submitted to the office of the Deputy Registrar (Private Registration) either directly or by post.

DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED ALONG WITH THE APPLICATION

- Original chalan receipt for the required fee.
- Original Transfer Certificate(T.C)
- Original and copies of Qualifying Certificate and Mark Lists.
- Self attested copy of SSLC/Equivalent for proof of Age and Date of Birth.
- Those who are eligible for mark relaxation should submit the relevant documents to prove their claim.
- Self addressed envelope(without stamp) of size 30cm x 25cm.
- Those who have completed Plus Two through National Institute of Open Schooling(NIOS) should submit an Equivalency Certificate issued from the University of Calicut.
- Those who have already registered for any degree examination and discontinued the Programme must produce a Cancellation Memo from the concerned University.

STEPS FOR ONLINE REGISTRATION.

1. Pay the required fee(Private Registration Fee, Matriculation Fee, Postage/Spot Registration Fee etc as applicable) through the Instant Web Payment System provided in the University website. (www.universityofcalicut.info > InstantWebPaymentSystem). Select the purpose as "OTH00054 - Private Registration UG Admission 2017" and fill in the required fields and pay the amount using Internet Banking/Debit Card/Credit card etc.
2. Take the printout of the chalan receipt.
3. A security code will be sent to the mobile number entered at the time of payment.
4. After receiving the security code, select "Online Registration" link in the website.(www.universityofcalicut.info>OnlineRegistration)
5. Select "**OTH00054-Private Registration UG Admission 2017**"
6. Enter the chalan number and security code and validate the chalan
7. Upload the photograph in JPEG format
8. Fill in all the relevant fields in the application form.

9. Verify all the details before submitting the application.
10. Submit the application and take a printout.
11. Get the application form attested by a Gazetted Officer and put the signature of the applicant in the required fields.
