University of Calicut

The University of Calicut is the largest University in Kerala. Established in the year 1968, it is the second university to be set up in Kerala. The University aims to nurture excellence in education and research in its catchment areas of Northern Kerala, historically consigned to the periphery of Kerala's academic map. The University lays its emphasis on fostering quality human resource and promoting productive research that benefit both local communities and wider humanity. The University was created through a Government plan bifurcating Kerala University. As per the plan, the four post-graduate departments of the University of Kerala operating in Calicut were annexed to the new University along with fifty four constituent colleges spread across seven northern districts. With *'Nirmaya Karmana Sree'* as it motto, the University has been able to surmount all challenges and emerge as the largest residential cum affiliating University in Kerala. With 30 post graduate departments and 426 colleges it has become a beacon of hope and enlightenment for hundreds of thousands of young men and women in North Kerala. **As** many as 480 colleges are affiliated to the University. Of these, 120 are located in Kozhikode district, 101 in Thrissur, 130 in Malappuram, 86 in Palakkad and 18 in Wayanad.

Duration of the Programme

The BA History programme consists of total six semesters spreading of three years.

Faculty and support staff requirements

The History programme of school of distance education has two Assistant Professors on contract in which one is in charge of the BA programme. The administrative works are run by sufficient number of staffs from SDE. The SLM preparation is carried out by a panel of

experts appointed by university committee. Contact classes and internal evaluation are also conducted in the same manner.

Instructional Delivery Mechanisms

The students of SDE will be offered contact classes at various contact class centres. The details regarding the centres are given by time to time. A student can choose contact class centres at the time of online registration. The allotment of contact centres will depend on the number of students enrolled on the programme. If sufficient number of candidates is not enrolled for a programme, the nearest contact class centre will be allotted. No contact class will be provided if the enrolment for the programme is less than 20. The time table of contact classes will be send to the students well in advance. The classes will be handled by teachers of SDE, teachers of the colleges affiliated to the universities and by the experts in the contact field.

Financial Assistance

Students belonged to SC/ST/OEC category will be admitted in SDE without remitting the tuition fee at the time of admission only if they are not employed in Govt/ Quasi Govt/public sector services. Visually Challenged candidates are also eligible for fee concession on production of Medical Certificate.

Programme Delivery

Self Learning Materials and contact classes are the ways in which the curriculum is delivered to the student community. Plans were under discussion to introduce web based tools to make the studies more advanced.

Evaluation

Both internal and external assessment methods are used to evaluate the BA History programme. In this system, 20 percentage internal and 80 percentage external calculation systems are applied for the total evaluation.

Requirement of the Laboratory Support and Library Recourses

The laboratory is not required for BA History programme. The SDE has a separate library of its own with a good collection of books, periodicals, reference books etc: -Students can make use of library recourses and the reference service on all working days by producing their student ID card. At present SDE library has total 4020 books in which around 350 are related to history.
