Post Graduate Diploma in Rehabilitation Psychology (PGDRP)-2016-17 (Recognized by Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI), Govt. of India)

Intake Capacity: 10 candidates

Duration of Programme: 1 year (regular professional clinical programme based on Scientific Practitioner Model)

Syllabus: RCI approved syllabus of PGDRP

Nature: course consisted of theory and practical papers as per the RCI approved syllabus, In addition to this, students have to undergo 900 clinical hours of training under the supervision of faculty members in different clinical units such as Walk-in Clinic, Assessment Clinic, Developmental Psychotherapy Unit, Early Intervention Unit, Neuro-developmental Clinic, Learning Disability Clinic, Autism Clinic, Cognitive Rehabilitation, Vocational Rehabilitation and Community Clinic.

Eligibility Criteria: Post Graduation in Psychology (Regular) from University of Calicut or equivalent, with minimum 55% marks (50% marks for applicants under reserved categories SC/ST & OBC).

Admission procedure: Entrance examination & interview

Application Procedure: Application form can be downloaded from the website of University of Calicut

Application Fee Rs.300/- for General, In-service, (Rs.100 for reserved)
