Conditions and Guidelines:-

1. A fee of Rs.400/- (SC/ST Rs.170/) shall be remitted to Calicut University Fund by e-payment (SBI online/SBI e-chalan/Friends/Akshaya e-chalan/payment gateway). Please click the link "fee remittance" in the Admission Website (www.cuonline.ac.in) or the link "Instant Web Payment System" in the Official Website of the University (www.universityofcalicut.info) for remitting fee. **Choose the correct purpose of remittance** while processing the challan.
2. The ethnic native Lakshadweep candidates are exempted from the entrance examinations based on the sponsorship letter from the Lakshadweep

administration, subject to eligibility.

3. A candidate , if eligibile, may register upto four seperate programmes within ten options if available by using single registration fee. If the candidate applied for four programmes , seperate print out shall be send to the department concerned.

4. Apply online (**from 07.04.2018 to 21.04.2018**) through the website www.cuonline.ac.in. Click on the link 'Entrance Courses ". Enter challan number and Pass word and go ahead for completing the registration process.

5. The print out of applications along with the e-chalan receipt and self attested copies of certificates as proof of qualifications, age and community should be forwarded to the Head of the Department/Co-ordinator/Director as the case may be as mentioned in the 6 th column of the Notification so as to reach on or before 5 P.M on 24.04.2018.

6. The online Registration I.D.No. is mandatory for downloading hall tickets for the entrance examinations. This I.D.No should also be kept and mentioned by the candidate in all future communications. Hence, the candidates are advised to keep a copy of the print out of the application also with them for reference as well as to produce the same whenever required.

7. Those who are awaiting the results of the qualifying examination can also apply. They have to submit the copies of Marklist/Grade card to the Head/Director/ Co-ordinator, as the case may be, in order to finalise the Rank list in stipulated time.

8. Candidates are permitted to submit marklist/grade card of the qualifing examination at least 45 days from the commencement of class if admission is based on marks of the entrance examination only.

9. The Heads/Co-ordinators are authorized to conduct Entrance and admissions as per rules and allot students to affiliated colleges/Centres.

10. Allotment to the affiliated colleges will be made to fill the merit seat.

11. All candidates seeking admission including those who seek admission under Management quota in affiliated/self financing colleges shall register online. The candidates who seek admission under management quota shall produce a copy of the print out of the application at the college where they propose to take admission.

12. No memo will be sent to the candidates in respect of entrance examination, entrance examination result, Counselling etc. Candidates shall update themselves with the University Website (www.cuonline.ac.in/www.universityofcalicut.info) and the University Press releases for knowing the latest information.

13. Schedule of Entrance examination is given as Annexure No I.

14.The admission committee constituted by the Department Council will onduct the entrance examination and admission for PG/UG courses offered at the Departments.

15. The type of questions can be objective only, descriptive only or a combination of objective and descriptive questions. If it is a combination, the proportion of marks for objective and descriptive questions can be 50% each. If the entrance examination includes objective type questions alone, 1/3 marks be deducted for each wrong answer. If it includes combination of objective type and descriptive type questions or descriptive questions only no negative scores that is no deduction of marks for wrong answers.

16. The admitted candidates shall provide marklist of the qualifying examination at least 45 days from the date of admission, otherwise the student concerned should relinquish the seat. Students should provide a signed declaration in this regard at the time of admission.

17. The duration of the entrance examination has to be 2 hours except for Master of Arts in Journalism and Mass Communication (3 hours).

18. If any department fails to obtain enough number of students for admission, permission would be granted to conduct a second entrance examination with a new notification by June 15.

19. There will be entrance examination centres in Thiruvananthapuram, Ernakulam, Thrissur and Calicut University. If a student intend to appear for the entrance examination in more than one programme, he/she should opt only a single centre for all the programmes. However the centre opted by an applicant is only his/her option. But the University may allot a different Centre either due to shortage of applicants or any other reasons. Actual centre will be allotted by University of Calicut which will be the final. The exact venue, date and time of the Entrance Examination will be there in the Hall Ticket which has to be downloaded by the applicant from the University admission website .

20. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.
