

## P.G. Diploma in Rehabilitation Psychology (PGDRP)-2019-20

(Recognized by REHABILITATION COUNCIL OF INDIA -Govt. of India)

Intake Capacity: 15 Students

Nature & Duration of Programme: 1 year regular professional clinical programme through scientific practitioner model.

This one year programme consisted:- four core theory papers, one practical in Rehabilitation Intervention and clinical submission. In addition to this, students has to undergo 900 clinical hours of training under the supervision of faculty in different clinical units such as Walk-in Clinic, Assessment Clinic, Developmental Psychotherapy Unit, Early Intervention Unit, Neuro-developmental Clinic, Learning Disability Clinic, Autism Clinic, Cognitive Rehabilitation, Vocational Rehabilitation and Community Clinics.

Fee structure: As per the University Guidelines (Self-financing mode), Details are available in the prospectus.

Eligibility Criteria: Post Graduation in Psychology(Regular) from University of Calicut or equivalent, with minimum 55% marks (50% marks for applicants under reserved categories SC/ST & OBC).

Admission procedure: Entrance examination & interview

Application Procedure: Application form downloaded from the website of University of Calicut Application Fee: Rs.300/- for General, In-service, (for reserved category applicants application fee will be Rs.100/-)
