About CHMK Library

C. H. Mohammed Koya Library, the central library of the University of Calicut is the centre of knowledge which caters to the information needs of the academic community of Malabar region in particular. It has a collection of more than one lakh books and it subscribes to print and online Journals for supporting study, research and teaching. The Library is fully automated and the catalogue of the University Library and Departmental Libraries is available online in an integrated platform. The Library uses KOHA ILS for automation. The library is located at the main campus at Thenhipalam on the side of the National Highway 66 (Panvel - Kochi - Kanyakumari) and is 23 Kilometers away from the historic city of Kozhikode (Calicut). The nearest Airport is Calicut Airport which is about 9 Kms away from the main campus.

About the Workshop
