

THE UNIVERSITY

Poster Presentation

Poster should have a length of 120cm and width of 90cm. The main heading, sub heading(s), author(s) name and text should have the font size of 70, 48, 42 and 24 respectively. Non-degradable materials (plastic/flex) should be avoided.

Accepted full length research papers, on specific request from the authors, will be considered for publication with ISBN after a peer review process by duly constituted Editorial Committee. Authors consent for publication will be sought after the intimation of acceptance
