NOTIFICATION

The results of the Sixth Semester B.A./B.Com. examinations April 2020 have been published on 30.06.2020 and the B.Sc./BCA results will be released on 08.07.2020. The results will be available in the University website <https://results.uoc.ac.in> with effect from the above dates.

Since the restrictions due to Covid-19 pandemic are in force, the students are requested to avoid visits to the University in person for any services or clarifications related to these results. For any clarifications and services, the students are requested to use the facility provided through the **Student eHelp Portal** <https://support.uoc.ac.in>.

- In case there are students whose grace marks are not reflected in the results published, they may bring the matter to the notice of the University through the e-help portal mentioned above. Action taken on such requests will be intimated to the student through the portal. The marks obtained in such cases will be included in the Consolidated Grade Card, which will be distributed to the candidates from the colleges concerned.
- Applications for grace marks received so far have been processed and eligible grace marks have been awarded. Those students who have not applied for effecting grace mark in any semester so far should apply for the same urgently and the grace mark will be effected and the Consolidated Grade Card will be issued later.
- Those students who have already applied to include the marks gained in revaluation and do not find those changes in marks in the results published may intimate the matter to the University through the Student eHelp Portal and the same will be effected before issuing the Consolidated Grade Card.
- The students who have appeared for the Sixth Semester supplementary examination (April 2020) and passed the examination can apply for revising their Consolidated Grade Card accordingly. This may be done by submitting an application available in the University Website www.uoc.ac.in (in the link – forms to download) by Speed/Registered Post, giving their essential details including postal address with their contact number. The application shall accompany the Original Consolidated Grade Card already issued to the applicant, chalan receipts (i) for fee of Rs.315/- towards revision of Grade Card and (ii) Rs.50/- towards postal charges (Total Rs.365/-). The fee may be paid online through the University website. The University will send the revised Consolidated Grade Card by Post to the student.
- The students who have appeared for the Sixth Semester improvement examination (April 2020) may obtain their revised Provisional Certificate and Consolidated Grade Card. They may submit their application (in the link - forms to download) available in the University Website www.uoc.ac.in furnishing essential details including postal address. The application shall accompany the Original Consolidated Grade Card and Provisional Certificate already issued to the applicant, the chalan receipts (i) for fee of Rs.315/- towards revision of Grade Card, (ii) Rs.150/- towards revision of Provisional Certificate and (iii) Rs.50/- towards postal charges (Total Rs.515/-). The fee may be paid online through the University website. The University will send the revised certificates by Post to the student.
- The students who have availed readmission during the course may not find their results in the University website. Such students are requested to intimate the matter in the Student eHelp Portal given above.

- Those who need Consolidated Grade Card urgently for higher studies or other purposes may use the printout of the grade card that will be available in the University website.
- Those Students whose results are withheld owing to reason shown against the Register Number can also contact the University through the above eportal and necessary instructions and remedies will be provided.
- The date of distribution of Consolidated Grade Card and Provisional Certificate in respect of the regular students will be intimated later. The Students can collect the same from the respective Colleges from where they have attended the examination by observing Covid protocol.
- The last dates for applying for revaluation are as follows:

B.Com - 17th July 2020

BA - will be notified shortly

B.Sc/BCA - Notification will be issued after publication of results.

In view of the Covid-19 restrictions, students are requested to co-operate with the University authorities by using the service of the Student eHelp Portal and avoiding visits to the University Campus.
