ORDER

In continuation to fixing of mandatory number of answer scripts to be evaluated without remuneration by teachers drawing UGC scale of pay, the Syndicate vide reference cited 1st above, resolved that the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Examinations will prepare a proposal after studying the revision of rates of remuneration for the valuation of answer scripts and specail allowance to the Examiners.

Acordingly, the SC on Examinations, as per paper read as 2nd above, constituted a four member sub committee to study the matter in detail. The Sub committee's recommendations as per paper read as 3rd above, were considered by the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on examination held on 25/04/2017 vide reference cited 4th above, and resolved to place the recommendations of the Sub committee before the Syndicate for consideration.

The Syndicate as per paper read as 5th above, resolved to approve the following recommendations of the Sub committee and also resolved to revise the remuneration for the valuation of answer scripts of UG courses as ₹15/- per paper and for PG courses as ₹22/- per paper. The following are the recommendations of the sub committee which are approved by the Syndicate:-

1.TA/DA may be given to examiners as per the prevailing Govt. Rules/Orders instead of SEDA.

- 2. With a view to ensuring participation of all teachers in C V Camps and publication of results on time, the examiners / teachers are permitted to opt C V Camps centre of their choice with prior intimation to the Controller of Examinations.
 - 3. Existing rate will continue for evaluation of answer scripts of SDE.
 - 4. Chairman's fee in respect of the C V Camp may be enhanced to ₹1000/- per C V Camp.
- 5. Considered the request from Chairman, Afsal-UL-Uluma Preliminary, and recommended that since Afsal-Ul-Uluma Preliminary course is equal to Plus Two Humanities group as per സ. ഉ. (ആർ.ടി) നം. 2165/2014/ചൊ.വി.വ dated, 03/06/2014 and the teachers of this programme are not drawing UGC scale of pay, the Order No. 231/2017/PB dated 29/03/2017 fixing mandatory number of papers to be evaluated by teachers/examiners as part of duty is not applicable to the teachers of Afsal-Ul-Uluma Preliminary and also recommended to pay remuneration to them for the evaluation of all answer scripts at the revised rate applicable.

6.Registration fee per paper (both theory & practical) be enhanced by ₹10/-.

Sanction has therefore been accorded by the Hon'ble Vice- Chancellor to implement the decision of the Syndicate.

Orders are issued accordingly.
