ORDER

As per paper read as 1st above, the mandatory number of answer scripts to be evaluated by the teachers drawing UGC scale of pay as part of duty (free of remuneration) is fixed. In this regard EAC Section, Finance Branch vide reference cited 2nd above, sought clarifications and requested to reconsider the provisions already fixed and the difficulties that may arise during verification before effecting the payment.

The matter was placed before the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Examinations held on 25/04/2017, and the SC on Examinations vide paper read as 3rd above, resolved to place it before the Syndicate with some recommendations.

As per paper read as 4th above, the Syndicate held on 06/05/2017 resolved the following:-

1).Accept the following recommendations of the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Examinations

held on 25/04/2017.

a).Date of effect of the guidelines will be date of the University Order (U.O.No. 231/2017/PB

dated 29/03/2017) issued.

b).Remuneration will be paid to teachers of self financing colleges and other Universities without considering any mandatory minimum / part of duty as in the case of teachers drawing UGC scale of salary.

c).Mandatory numbers applicable for PG Diploma & M.Phil will be equal to that of PG courses and UG Diploma equal to that of UG courses.

d).Mandatory numbers for Chairman / Chief Examiner will be same as that of additional examiners.

e).External examiners from other Universities will be paid remuneration as per rules without deducting

any mandatory minimum as the evaluation is not their part of duty.

2). To fix the number of papers to be evaluated by a teacher per semester mandatorily and without remuneration as given below:
