Online applications are invited to prepare a panel for the post of Lecturers in English at Calicut University Centres in Andrott & Kadmat. The selection will be on the basis of the interview conducted by the University. Candidates are requested to submit their Bio-data through university website www.universityofcalicut.info on or before **25/03/2018**

The eligibility and remuneration for the post are as follows:

Age limit: Not above 65 years as on 1/6/2018

- In the absence of the qualified candidates, candidates without NET/Ph.D. but, having other prescribed qualifications will be considered. Monthly consolidated salary of Non NET hands will be ₹33,000/- P.M.
- The interview will be exclusively for preparing a panel for the post of Lecturer in English at Calicut University Centres in Andrott & Kadmat Islands under a package programme approved by the University of Calicut and the Union Territory of Lakshadweep Administration.
- The interview will be conducted to prepare a panel to appoint candidate for the anticipated vacancies.
- The eligible candidates from the approved panel will be engaged on contract basis in the vacancies reported from the academic year 2018-19 onwards.
- The validity of the approved panel will be for a period of one year from the date of publication and the University may extend the validity depending upon the requirements.
- The contract engagements will be initially for a period of one year extendable upto three years on the basis of the performance evaluation report of the academic head.
- The candidates should furnish the details of the qualifications possessed by them as prescribed by

the University in the online application form.

- Candidates shortlisted for interview will be informed of by e-mail/phone/mobile number.
- The candidates shortlisted for interview should report at least one hour before the commencement of interview with the following documents in original.
 1. Two copies of the online print out of the application form with proper attestation.
 2. The certificates in original as proof of qualification, age, experience, community/caste and nativity in the case of Lakshadweep candidates.
 3. For qualifying degree certificates from the Universities other than the State of Kerala, an equivalency certificate.
- The candidates who fail to produce the original testimonials in support of qualification and experience at the time of spot verification will not be permitted to attend the interview.
- Preference will be given to the qualified candidates from Lakshadweep in the engagements over the qualified candidates from the Mainland.
- Preference will be given to the Non NET candidates from Lakshadweep in the engagements over Non NET candidates from the Mainland.
- **The Mainlanders as well as Islanders, both qualified and non qualified teachers, presently working at the Centre shall apply for the post to attend the interview for their respective discipline. Due weightage for the experience in teaching at Calicut University Laksha Dweep Centers will be given. All kind of vacancies arising including the renewal vacancies will be filled from the ranklist to be published on the basis of this notification.**
