The walk-in-interview for the appointment of Assistant Professors on contract basis for the conduct of Forensic Science Programme functioning at Kerala Police Academy, Thrissur, for 'OPEN' and 'MUSLIM' vacancies will be held in the Administrative Block, University of Calicut as per the following schedule::

Qualifications:

(1) 55 % marks at the Masters Degree Level in the relevant subject (Forensic Science) of an Indian/Foreign University recognized as thereto as specified in the hand book issued by AIU from time to time.

(2) Must have cleared NET.

(3) Candidates who have been awarded Ph.D in the concerned subject shall be exempted from the requirement of NET.

In the absence of candidates having NET/PhD, those with 55% marks and above in Masters Degree (Forensic Science) will be considered. The Assistant Professors on contract basis with minimum qualification prescribed for the post of Assistant Professor shall be eligible for a consolidated remuneration of ₹ 42,000/-per month. Assistant Professors on contract basis without minimum qualifications, but with 55 % marks at Masters Degree are eligible for a consolidated remuneration of ₹ 25,000/- per month.

Age limit as on 01/01/2019: Below 40 years (Upper age limit prescribed will be relaxed in the case of OBC, SC/ST and Physically Challenged persons by 3 years, 5 years and 10 years respectively subject to the relevant provisions of KS & SSR).

General Instructions:

1. The appointments on contract basis shall be for a period up to the end of the academic year 2019-2020.
2. No appointment made in one academic year shall extend to the next academic year. Reengagement will not be considered after the completion of the term of the appointment.
3. Candidates should produce original certificates to prove age, qualifications and community at the time of interview.
4. Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from other Universities should produce Recognition Certificate at the time of interview.
5. No TA/DA will be paid for the journey to attend the interview.
6. Candidates should reach the office of Recruitment Section, Administrative Block half an hour before the stipulated time on the day of interview for certificate verification.
